

CAUTION!

- The Ascent Lift is under strong spring force and must be transported in the open position.
- The Ascent Lift must be securely attached to the cabinet/ structure walls and made stable to carry the intended load when operated.
- · The Ascent Lift is designed for vertical use only.
- Do not operate the lift without attaching adequate counterbalance weights. See the weight matrix on page four.

Installation Instructions

NOTE: The following minimum dimensions do not take into consideration the additional cabinet space required for screen width or depth. Be sure to provide adequate clearance for the intended screen or component. Maximum screen or component height is 17.5" [450] tall, and 22" diagonal.







Access: Locate and drill 2.0" [50 mm] access hole (Figure 3)









Lift Installation

Locate and mark the centerline of the cabinet opening. Mark and pre-drill mounting holes. Install six #6 X 10 screws into the fixing holes as shown in Figure 4.




Lower the lift (see Figure 5) to the mid-travel point to expose the final two mounting holes. Install two #6 X 10 screws and secure.




Bracket Installation

Install television/screen mounting bracket (not included). See the bracket kit technical sheet for detailed installation instructions (Figure 6).



Television/Screen Installation


Install television/screen to mounting bracket (not included) (Figure 7). See the bracket kit technical sheet for detailed installation instructions. Note the detail below for minimum clearance dimensions for cabinet lids (Figure 7i).




Route cables through wiring access hole in cabinet (Figure 8A). Insert cables through the opening of the wire grommet of the cable clamp (Figure 8B).

Insert wires into the bottom of the lift column and route to top of the column opening and to the back of the television/screen (Figure 8C and 8D).

Adjust the cable slack and attach the cable clamp (Figure 8B).



Install the edge protector on to the column opening to prevent wire damage (Figure 9).



Counterbalance Weight Installation

Weight plates are installed to counterbalance the weight of the television/screen.

The Ascent Lift comes with one weight pack, which includes 10 units @ 3.88 oz. [110 gm] each, totaling 2.43 lbs. [1.1 kgs.]. See the chart (next page) to determine the potential number of weight packs required for your specific installation. Additional optional weight packs may be ordered.

If more than two weight packs are required, order the Weight Extension Plate Kit (P/N 2990-9775-BE).

Important: Inadequate weight may cause the unit to lift too quickly. Too much weight will override the spring-action movement.






- Weights less than this may not provide enough counterbalance for the mechanism and could cause rapid movement that may damage the unit or the installed item.
- ** Weights above this may override the spring-action of the lift, requiring manual movement.

Installing Weights

Remove nuts (figure 10-1), add weight plates, and secure nuts (figure 10-2). Fully close the Ascent and then press to release to test the counterbalancing. Add or remove one plate at a time to test movement.







Adding more than two weight packs requires the Weight Extension Plate Kit. To install the extension plate, remove nuts and weights, install extension plates, replace weights, and secure (figure 10-3). Add weights as required and test after each addition.
